WHAT DO WE DO?

We provide low cost spay/neuter services for cats and dogs
Our mobile surgical suite travels to NJ areas of greatest need
We improve the lives of those we serve, both pets & people

We work daily to end the uncontrolled breeding of pets
We are dedicated to reducing companion animal homelessness
We offer guidance and spay/neuter services to 1500 families a year
and the euthanasia of dogs and cats simply for lack of enough homes

WHO DO WE SERVE?

We reduce local animal control costs for NJ taxpayers
We serve individual pet guardians, pet rescue groups, and animal shelters
We serve companion animals and responsibly maintained feral cat colonies

WHAT IS OUR OPERATING HISTORY?

We have operated our mobile spay/neuter clinic since 2006
Our initial funding was provided by a grant from the **Dodge Foundation**
Funding has been provided by **Pet Smart Charities**, **PetCo Foundation**, **DJ&T Foundation**,
and **Build-a-Bear Foundation**, as well as from individual donors and corporate sponsors

When not traveling, our mobile clinic is at the PetCo in Totowa, NJ
When traveling, our mobile clinic is regularly seen on Rts. 3, 46, 23, NJ TPK and GSP
